South African citizens and Residents (with ID):	R128 per adult, per day	R64 per child, per day
SADC Nationals (with passport):	R257 per adult, per day	R128 per child, per day
Standard Conservation Fee (Foreign Visitors):	R535 per adult, per day	R267 per child, per day





The Rate Per Person includes the following:

- Transfers from Nelspruit Lodge to Kruger and back
- Snack box per person including a packet of crisps, a chocolate bar, a packet of biscuits, a packet of savory snacks, 200ml juice, and 500ml bottled mineral water
- Accredited & Professional Guide doubling as the driver of the vehicle
- Full day safari with a luxury open safari vehicle; pick up will be approx. 04:00am and exiting the Park approx. 14:00. This day will have a 45min breakfast stop & a 1-hour lunch stop at a rest camp or picnic site with a restaurant – for your own account
- Assisting guests with conservation/entrance fee payments when entering the Park
- The use of waterproof ponchos on-board the vehicle when needed

The Rate Per Person excludes the following:

- Kruger National Park Daily entrance/conservation fees
- Any meals, extra snacks and refreshments (no alcohol allowed for day visitors)
- Anything else the Park has to offer
- Anything else not mentioned
- Guide's Tip (optional of course, yet very welcome)

Exclusive use of the vehicle (no sharing with other guest) – R5400 total

Includes & excludes everything as per above, except snack boxes. Only 2 x 500ml mineral water per person will be included

How can you pay for the safari?

We need full payment to confirm all bookings. You can either pay via card or EFT:

CARD – Lion Roar Safaris make use of a safe & secure online card payment system that are very user-friendly. A payment link will be sent directly to you. No need to share sensitive card information with anyone. Important – only 3D secure cards can be used to make payment. Diners and Amex not accepted.

EFT – You can make EFT payment; an invoice with the Banking Details will be issued.

What to bring on safari? (These are all optional, suggestions only)

- Something warm to wear – it can be cold on the back of the open vehicle (check the weather prior to the safari and dress accordingly)
- Sunscreen, sunglasses & hat or cap
- Extra snacks & refreshments (NO alcohol allowed for day visitors)
